

The East Coast Trip Border Crossing Info

Student and youth groups are exempt from adult border crossing rules.

Students Born in the United States

Students will need a Certified Birth Certificate

This is the one from Kent County or whichever county your child was born in. It is not the one from the hospital

Students will also need a pictured I.D.

This can be a school issued one, one from a health club etc.

or

A Passport, if they have one

or

State issued Enhanced I.D.s can be obtained from your local
Secretary of State office

(takes about six weeks to receive and there is a charge for this)

Foreign-Born Students

Students or those who are not U.S. Citizens,
will need to call the following numbers to find out what
documentation they will need to successfully enter
Canada and then re-enter the United States.
