Terms and Conditions

Reservations, Deposits, Final Payments: Reservations will be accepted on a first come/first served basis with a deposit of \$100.00 made payable to Countryside Tours, Inc. Reservation coupon and check must be sent to Countryside Tours, Inc., P.O. Box 48, Sand Lake, Michigan 49343-0048. Final payment will be due on, or prior to, March 31, 2021. Late payments will be assessed a penalty of \$25.00.

Insufficient Fund Checks: There will be a \$20.00 charge for checks with insufficient funds.
Tour Cost: The tour cost as advertised in this brochure is based on current costs and tariffs in effect at the time of printing. Should these change, an adjustment (either way) will result. If the advertised tour cost is increased by more than 5%, you may cancel within 10 days of notification and receive a full refund.

Cancellations and Refunds: Cancellations MUST be made in writing (email is acceptable) to our office. For cancellations on or prior to the March payment deadline there will be a full refund less an administrative fee of \$50.00. For cancellations received after that date there will be no refund of the \$100.00 deposit. No-shows for your Spring Mandatory Meeting (without permission) will be dropped from the tour and the deposit will be forfeited. Cancellations after the March payment deadline are as follows: Cancellations received 30 days before the trip date will receive a 50% refund; Cancellations received 14 days before the trip date will receive a 25% refund; Cancellations received seven days before the trip or no-shows will receive no refund.

Broadway Theater Tickets: If your school's itinerary includes Broadway Theater Tickets, the cost of the ticket will be non-refundable after February 28, 2021.

Membership on Tours: Countryside Tours, Inc. reserves the right to accept, decline, or dismiss any person as a member of our tour. This is not a school sponsored trip. The group leader reserves the right to refund the deposit of, and deny the trip to, any student who does not demonstrate the self-discipline and responsible behavior necessary to participate successfully on this trip. Itinerary

Day 1 - June 6, 2021 - Sunday - D

We'll depart West Catholic High School parking lot at 5:30 am this morning for our exciting tour to the East Coast and Washington D.C.! We'll travel through Canada, so we can stop to see the Niagara Falls. Our first night will be spent in Albany, New York.

Day 2 - June 7, 2021 - Monday - CB, L, & D

An early start this morning will find us heading east. After some lunch in Boston, we will board the "Duck", a W.W.II-style, amphibious landing vehicle, and cruise by all places that make Boston the *Birthplace of Freedom*. Next, we will tour Fenway Park, home of the Boston Red Sox. After some dinner and shopping at Faneuil Hall, we will head to our hotel.

Day 3 - June 8, 2021 - Tuesday - CB, L, & D

Today will be spent exploring the "Big Apple". We will start with some time in Times Square and lunch at Bubba Gump Shrimp Company. We then tool around town aboard a double-decker bus, and then we will explore the 9/11 Memorial Museum, where we will learn of the events, the aftermath, and continuing implications of September 11, 2001. Finally, we take a heart-stopping thrill ride, on a 70-foot speedboat called The Beast. We end the day in NYC with dinner, before venturing on towards Washington D.C..

Day 4 - June 9, 2021 - Wednesday - CB, L, & D

We will depart for Washington D.C. to spend the afternoon exploring the Smithsonian Museums. After some dinner we will take a guided tour of our nation's memorials before heading to our hotel for the night.

Day 5 - June 10, 2021 - Thursday - CB, L, & D

After breakfast at the hotel we will take a tram ride through Arlington Cemetery for the Changing of the Guard Ceremony. We will have time for lunch and shopping at the Fashion Centre at Pentagon City Mall before we head for Gettysburg, where we will have dinner, before heading to our hotel for the night.

Day 6 - June 11, 2021 - Friday - CB, L, & D

This morning will be spent touring the Gettysburg National Military Park, with a Park Service Guide, and do some last minute souvenir shopping. This afternoon and evening, we'll enjoy the amusement rides at Hershey Park! Afterwards, we will reboard our motorcoach and head for home.

Day 7 - June 12, 2021 - Saturday

We will arrive back in West Michigan around 9:00 am.
