Terms and Conditions

Reservations, Deposits, Final Payments: Reservations will be accepted on a first come/first served basis with a deposit of \$100.00 made payable to Countryside Tours, Inc. Reservation coupon and check must be sent to Countryside Tours, Inc., P.O. Box 48, Sand Lake, Michigan 49343-0048. Final payment will be due on, or prior to, March 31, 2021. Late payments will be assessed a penalty of \$25.00.

Insufficient Fund Checks: There will be a \$20.00 charge for checks with insufficient funds.

Tour Cost: The tour cost as advertised in this brochure is based on current costs and tariffs in effect at the time of printing. Should these change, an adjustment (either way) will result. If the advertised tour cost is increased by more than 5%, you may cancel within 10 days of notification and receive a full refund.

Cancellations and Refunds: Cancellations MUST be made in writing (email is acceptable) to our office. For cancellations on or prior to the March payment deadline there will be a full refund less an administrative fee of \$50.00. For cancellations received after that date there will be no refund of the \$100.00 deposit. No-shows for your Spring Mandatory Meeting (without permission) will be dropped from the tour and the deposit will be forfeited. Cancellations after the March payment deadline are as follows: Cancellations received 30 days before the trip date will receive a 50% refund; Cancellations received 14 days before the trip date will receive a 25% refund; Cancellations received seven days before the trip or no-shows will receive no refund.

Broadway Theater Tickets: If your school's itinerary includes Broadway Theater Tickets, the cost of the ticket will be non-refundable after February 28, 2021.

Membership on Tours: Countryside Tours, Inc. reserves the right to accept, decline, or dismiss any person as a member of our tour. This is not a school sponsored trip. Itinerary

Day 1 - June 6, 2021 - Sunday - D

We'll depart Sparta Middle School at 5:30 am for our exciting tour to the East Coast and Washington D.C.! We will make a stop and learn of the heroic actions of the passengers and crew at the Flight 93 National Memorial, on our way to Washington D.C..

Day 2 - June 7, 2021 - Monday - CB, L, & D

We start our morning with a guided tour of our nation's memorials, and have some time to visit some Smithsonian Museums. After lunch, we will take a tram ride through Arlington Cemetery to witness the Changing of the Guard Ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Dinner will be at Pentagon Mall before we head out of town for Philadelphia.

Day 3 - June 8, 2021 - Tuesday - B, L, & D

After breakfast we start with a visit to Independence Hall and the National Constitution Center. We will see the Liberty Bell, and have some lunch, before we leave for New York City. Once in NYC, we will have dinner in Main Street Park under the Brooklyn Bridge. We then walk the Bridge to One World Observatory, where we take a 60-second elevator ride to the 100th floor for breathtaking views of NYC before we head to our hotel for the night.

Day 4 - June 9, 2021 - Wednesday - CB, L, & D

Today we continue to explore New York City, only this time it will be by Subway. We are going to learn how the locals get around town every day. We will also take a ride on the Beast, the 70 foot speed boat that will take us out to see the Statue of Liberty at 45mph. After some dinner, we head north to Boston.

Day 5 - June 10, 2021 - Thursday - CB, L, & D

An early start this morning will find us heading east. After lunch at Faneuil Hall, we will board the "Duck", a W.W.II-style, amphibious landing vehicle and cruise by all the places that make Boston the *Birthplace of Freedom*. Our evening will be spent at America's most beloved ballpark, Fenway Park, for a Boston Red Sox game and dinner.*

Day 6 - June 11, 2021 - Friday - CB, L, & D
