Brief Itinerary

Day 1 - Tuesday (MBS & D)

We start our adventure headed to Nashville with coffee and breakfast snacks. Along the way, we will make a quick stop for lunch (on your own). Upon arrival, we will check into our hotel before enjoying a fantastic dinner at Hermitage House Smorgasbord. After dinner, we will be joined by a successful local songwriter, who will play some of the hit songs they have written and answer questions about the recording industry. Then we will retire to our hotel for the evening.

Day 2 - Wednesday (CB & D)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will begin our day with a professional guided tour of the City of Nashville, with a self-guided tour of the Ryman Auditorium, a National Historic Landmark and a must see for anyone visiting Nashville. You'll enjoy a free afternoon for shopping and lunch (on your own), before returning to the hotel to freshen up for dinner at Jimmy Buffett's Margaritaville. Then we head to the Bridgestone Arena, to spend the evening at the live-taping of the *CMA Awards Show!*

Day 3 - Thursday (CB)

Breakfast will be at the hotel, before we depart for the RCA Studio B, where you will be a star for the day, with a personally guided tour of the "Home of 1,000 Hits", where music legends recorded timeless songs, and you have your own recording session, right where Elvis himself stood to record over 200 songs. Next, we explore the Country Music Hall of Fame, then we head to Opry Mills, Tennessee's premier shopping destination, with time for shopping and lunch on your own. Then it's on to the Gaylord Opryland Resort, with nine acres of indoor gardens, cascading waterfalls, and an indoor river with world-class shopping and dining. After, we will return to our hotel, and the evening is yours to enjoy downtown Nashville, with dinner on your own.

Day 4 - Friday (CB, L & D)

After breakfast, we depart for our tour of the Fontanel Mansion, a 27,000 sq.-ft. log home, formerly owned by Country Music Hall of Fame member Barbara Mandrell. Lunch will be at the Wildhorse Saloon. Following lunch, we will have time to freshen up at our hotel, or stay downtown and enjoy all that Nashville has to offer! Dinner will be at BB King's Restaurant, followed by an incredible evening at the Grand Ole Opry at the Ryman Auditorium, before heading back to our hotel for the night.

Day 5 - Saturday (CB)

Today we say goodbye to Nashville, as we begin our journey home, with a quick lunch stop (on your own) along the way. Approximate arrival in Grand Rapids at 6:00 pm.
