## Terms and Conditions

**Reservations, Deposits, Final Payments:** Reservations will be accepted on a first come/first served basis with a deposit of \$100.00 made payable to Countryside Tours, Inc. Reservation coupon and check must be sent to Countryside Tours, Inc., P.O. Box 48, Sand Lake, Michigan 49343-0048. Final payment will be due on, or prior to, March 31, 2021. Late payments will be assessed a penalty of \$25.00.

**Insufficient Fund Checks:** There will be a \$20.00 charge for checks with insufficient funds.

**Tour Cost:** The tour cost as advertised in this brochure is based on current costs and tariffs in effect at the time of printing. Should these change, an adjustment (either way) will result. If the advertised tour cost is increased by more than 5%, you may cancel within 10 days of notification and receive a full refund.

**Cancellations and Refunds:** Cancellations MUST be made in writing (email is acceptable) to our office. For cancellations on or prior to the March payment deadline there will be a full refund less an administrative fee of \$50.00. For cancellations received after that date there will be no refund of the \$100.00 deposit. No-shows for your Spring Mandatory Meeting (without permission) will be dropped from the tour and the deposit will be forfeited. Cancellations after the March payment deadline are as follows: Cancellations received 30 days before the trip date will receive a 50% refund; Cancellations received 14 days before the trip date will receive a 25% refund; Cancellations received seven days before the trip or no-shows will receive no refund.

**Broadway Theater Tickets:** If your school's itinerary includes Broadway Theater Tickets, the cost of the ticket will be non-refundable after February 28, 2021.

**Membership on Tours:** Countryside Tours, Inc. reserves the right to accept, decline, or dismiss any person as a member of our tour. This is not a school sponsored trip. # Itinerary

## Day 1 - June 14, 2021 - Monday - D

We'll depart Beal City High School at 6:00 am this morning for our exciting tour to the East Coast and Washington D.C.! We'll travel towards the East Coast, and our first night will be spent in Fairfield, New Jersey.

## Day 2 - June 15, 2021 - Tuesday - CB, L, & D

This is a day of exploring the "Big Apple". Our morning will start with a visit to the 9/11 Memorial Museum, where we will learn of the events, the aftermath and continuing implications of September 11, 2001. After lunch, we tour around town on a double decker bus, then we take a heart-stopping thrill ride aboard The Beast, out to see the Statue of Liberty. We will have time for some shopping and dinner in Times Square, before heading to our final stop, the Empire State Building for some fantastic views of the city from the 86th floor. We then travel to Philadelphia for the night.

## Day 3 - June 16, 2021 - Wednesday - CB, L, & D

After breakfast we will head into Philadelphia, where we will see the Liberty Bell, visit Independence Hall and the National Constitution Center that is filled with interactive displays. After lunch, we will visit the Eastern State Penitentiary, where some of America's most notorious criminals were held, before heading out of town for Washington D.C.. After dinner we will have some time to visit some memorials before heading to our hotel for the evening.

## Day 4 - June 17, 2021 - Thursday - CB, L, & D

This morning we will visit Mount Vernon to tour George Washington's beautiful home. After some lunch we will go to Arlington National Cemetery and see the Changing of the Guard Ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. We will spend some time touring some Smithsonian Museums, before having dinner and then a guided tour of our nations memorials before heading back to our hotel.

## Day 5 - June 18, 2021 - Friday - CB, L, & D

Our morning starts with a visit to the International Spy Museum, where we will test our spy skills and explore the world of spies. After lunch we will head for Gettysburg. Once in Gettysburg, we will visit the Shriver House, where we will learn what it was like being a civilian during the Battle of Gettysburg. Our dinner will be at General Pickett's before we take a Ghost Walk through the historic streets of town.

## Day 6 - June 19, 2021 - Saturday - CB, L, & D

This morning will be spent touring the Gettysburg National Military Park, with a Park Service Guide, and do some last minute souvenir shopping. This afternoon and evening, we'll enjoy the amusement rides at Hershey Park! Afterwards, we will re-board our motorcoach and head for home.

We will arrive back in Beal City at approximately 10:30 am.
