
**Taxes & Gratuities:** All taxes and gratuities for attractions and meals are included in the tour cost. Motorcoach driver's tip is appreciated.



### Brief Itinerary

#### Day 1 – Tuesday, August 3, 2021 - MBS & D

We start our day by heading to Dayton, Ohio where we will stop for lunch on our own at the well-known gourmet supermarket, Dorothy Lane Market. Following a late afternoon check in to the hotel, we will head to Cincinnati, Ohio to board the BB Riverboat for a dinner cruise to take in the breathtaking panoramic views of Cincinnati and the Ohio River.
