# Terms and Conditions

**Reservations, Deposits, Final Payments:** Reservations will be accepted on a first come/first served basis with a deposit of \$100.00 made payable to Countryside Tours, Inc. Reservation coupon and check must be sent to Countryside Tours, Inc., P.O. Box 48, Sand Lake, Michigan 49343-0048. Final payment will be due on, or prior to, March 31, 2022. Late payments will be assessed a penalty of \$25.00.

**Insufficient Fund Checks:** There will be a \$20.00 charge for checks with insufficient funds.  
**Tour Cost:** The tour cost as advertised in this brochure is based on current costs and tariffs in effect at the time of printing. Should these change, an adjustment (either way) will result. If the advertised tour cost is increased by more than 5%, you may cancel within 10 days of notification and receive a full refund.

**Cancellations and Refunds:** Cancellations MUST be made in writing (email is acceptable) to our office. For cancellations on or prior to the March payment deadline there will be a full refund less an administrative fee of \$50.00. For cancellations received after that date there will be no refund of the \$100.00 deposit. No-shows for your Spring Mandatory Meeting (without permission) will be dropped from the tour and the deposit will be forfeited. Cancellations after the March payment deadline are as follows: Cancellations received 30 days before the trip date will receive a 50% refund; Cancellations received 14 days before the trip date will receive a 25% refund; Cancellations received seven days before the trip or no-shows will receive no refund.

**Broadway Theater Tickets:** If your school's itinerary includes Broadway Theater Tickets, the cost of the ticket will be non-refundable after February 28, 2022.

**Membership on Tours:** Countryside Tours, Inc. reserves the right to accept, decline, or dismiss any person as a member of our tour. This is not a school sponsored trip. Mrs. Beth DePauw reserves the right to refund the deposit of, and deny the trip to, any student who does not demonstrate the self-discipline and responsible behavior necessary to participate successfully on this trip. Any student who becomes ineligible for his/her school's End of the Year Class trip will automatically become ineligible for this trip. Cancellation penalties will apply.

## Itinerary

### Day 1 - June 10, 2021 - Friday - D

We'll depart Greenville Middle School at 5:30 am this morning for our exciting tour to the East Coast and Washington D.C.! We'll travel through Canada, and stop to see Niagara Falls. Our first night will be spent in Albany, New York.

### Day 2 - June 11, 2022 - Saturday - CB, L, & D

An early start this morning will find us heading east. After some lunch in Boston, we will board the "Duck", a W.W.II-style, amphibious landing vehicle, and cruise by all the places that make Boston the *Birthplace of Freedom*. We will take a walk along the Freedom Trail and learn the history of the American Revolution, as it began in Boston. After some dinner and shopping at Faneuil Hall, we will head to our hotel for the night.

### Day 3 - June 12, 2022 - Sunday - CB, L, & D

Today will be spent exploring the "Big Apple". We will start with breathtaking views of NYC at the top of Rockefeller Center. After some lunch we will tour around town aboard a double decker bus. Then it is time for a heart-stopping thrill ride, on a 70-foot speedboat called The Beast. A stroll through Times Square and dinner at Bubba Gump Shrimp Company will complete our day, before heading to our hotel for the night.

### Day 4 - June 13, 2022 - Monday - CB, L, & D

This morning we will depart for Washington D.C., where we start with a visit to Mount Vernon, George Washington's beautiful home. The afternoon will be spent exploring the Smithsonian Museums. After dinner at Union Station, we take a guided tour of our nation's memorials.

### Day 5 - June 14, 2022 - Tuesday - CB, L, & D

Our morning will start with a tram ride through Arlington Cemetery for the Changing of the Guard Ceremony. After some lunch and shopping time at the Pentagon Mall we make our way to Gettysburg. Once in Gettysburg we will have dinner and take a Ghost Walk through the historic streets of town before heading to our hotel for the night.

### Day 6 - June 15, 2022 - Wednesday - CB, L, & D

This morning will be spent touring the Gettysburg National Military Park, with a Park Service Guide. We will have some lunch before heading out of town for Hershey, PA. This afternoon and evening, we'll enjoy the amusement rides at Hershey Park! Afterwards, we will reboard our motorcoach and head for home.

We will arrive back in West Michigan around 9:00 am.
