Terms and Conditions

Reservations, Deposits, Final Payments: Reservations will be accepted on a first come/first served basis with a deposit of \$100.00 made payable to Countryside Tours, Inc. Reservation coupon and check must be sent to Countryside Tours, Inc., P.O. Box 48, Sand Lake, Michigan 49343-0048. Final payment will be due on, or prior to, March 31, 2022. Late payments will be assessed a penalty of \$25.00.

Insufficient Fund Checks: There will be a \$20.00 charge for checks with insufficient funds.

Tour Cost: The tour cost as advertised in this brochure is based on current costs and tariffs in effect at the time of printing. Should these change, an adjustment (either way) will result. If the advertised tour cost is increased by more than 5%, you may cancel within 10 days of notification and receive a full refund.

Cancellations and Refunds: Cancellations MUST be made in writing (email is acceptable) to our office. For cancellations on or prior to the April payment deadline there will be a full refund less an administrative fee of \$50.00. For cancellations received after that date there will be no refund of the \$100.00 deposit. Cancellations after the March payment deadline are as follows: Cancellations received 30 days before the trip date will receive a 50% refund; Cancellations received 14 days before the trip date will receive a 25% refund; Cancellations received seven days before the trip or no-shows will receive no refund.

Broadway Theater Tickets: If your school's itinerary includes Broadway Theater Tickets, the cost of the ticket will be non-refundable after February 28, 2022.

Membership on Tours: Countryside Tours, Inc. reserves the right to accept, decline, or dismiss any person as a member of our tour. This is not a school sponsored trip. Mr. Robert Morrison reserves the right to refund the deposit of, and deny the trip to, any student who does not demonstrate the self-discipline and responsible behavior necessary to participate successfully on this trip. Any student who becomes ineligible in extracurricular activities, or receives 3 or more days of suspension, may not be eligible for this trip. Cancellation penalties will apply.

Itinerary

Day 1 - June 25, 2022 - Saturday - D

We'll depart Tri County High School parking lot at 5:00 am this morning for our exciting tour to the East Coast! We'll travel through Canada, where we will stop and see the Niagara Falls. Our first night will be spent in West Springfield, Massachusetts.

Day 2 - June 26, 2022 - Sunday - CB, L, & D

An early start this morning will find us heading east. We will start with a stop at Harvard University and a walk around the beautiful campus. Next, it is into Boston for some lunch at the Prudential Center before we board the "Duck", a W.W.II-style, amphibious landing vehicle, and cruise by all places that make Boston the *Birthplace of Freedom*. Next, we will take a walk along the Freedom Trail and learn the history of the American Revolution, as it began in Boston. Our dinner will be at the famous Fire & Ice Grill, where you choose your own ingredients, and then watch their Grill Chefs create your meal on the world's largest grill. We will be spending the night just outside of Boston.

Day 3 - June 27, 2022 - Monday - CB, L, & D

This will be another day exploring Boston. We will tour Fenway Park, home of the Boston Red Sox. We will visit the floating Boston Tea Party Ships & Museum, before having lunch and some shopping time at Quincy Market Place. Our final stop will be the New England Aquarium before heading out of town for New York City.

Day 4 - June 28, 2022 - Tuesday - CB, L, & D

Today is the day to explore the "Big Apple". Our morning will start with a walk around Battery Park, then we will visit One World Observatory and take a sixty-second elevator ride to the 100th floor, for breathtaking views of NYC. After lunch, we then tool around town aboard a double-decker bus. Finally, we take a heart-stopping thrill ride, on a 70-foot speedboat called The Beast. We end the day in NYC with dinner at Margaritaville before venturing on to Philadelphia for the night.

Day 5 - June 29, 2022 - Wednesday - CB, L, & D

We will start the morning in Philadelphia, where we will walk past Independence Hall, see the Liberty Bell, and visit the National Constitution Center that is filled with interactive displays. We then visit Eastern State Penitentiary, where some of America's most notorious criminals were held. We will grab a box lunch and head for Washington D.C.. Our first stop in D.C. will be the National Portrait Gallery, we will have dinner at Hard Rock Cafe before finishing the evening with visits to the beautiful memorials.

Day 6 - June 30, 2022 - Thursday - CB, L, & D

Before heading out of town, we will tour Arlington National Cemetery and see the Changing of the Guard Ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. This afternoon and evening, we'll enjoy the amusement rides at Hershey Park! Afterwards, we will reboard our motorcoach and head for home.

We will arrive back in West Michigan around 10:30 am.
