Reservations, Deposits, Final Payments: Reservations can be made on-line or with the reservation coupon mailed to our office. Your deposit (or full payment depending on tour) is due at the time of reservation. It is important that the name and date of the tour appear on your remittance. Your reservation is not considered confirmed until your deposit is received. Final payment is due 30 days prior to departure unless otherwise noted on the tour brochure. If final payment is not received by the due date, you will be removed from the tour and the deposit will be non-refundable.

Cancellations and Refunds: Cancellations must be made in writing to our office (e-mail is acceptable).

Cancellations received:

Anytime after paying a deposit - \$25.00

60 - 31 days before the trip date - \$50.00

30 - 15 days before the trip date will receive a 25% refund minus all non-recoverable costs of transportation, admission tickets, accommodations and services

14 days or less before the trip date will receive NO REFUND

Any refunds needed for those who pay via credit cards will be made by a Countryside Tours check, minus 3% processing fees.

Brief Itinerary:

Day 1, Thursday, May 5, 2022 (BTG, L, & D)

As we depart from Grand Rapids this morning, we will enjoy breakfast snacks and coffee en route to Shipshewana, Indiana. We will arrive at Davis Mercantile, which features 4 floors of shops, eateries PLUS a working carousel. Lunch will be served inside Millie's Market Cafe' located on the top floor. Then you "shop 'til you drop" inside Lolly's Fabrics & Quilts and the shops at Davis Mercantile. We then head over to Yoder's Department Store, the largest quilting store in the region. You can walk across the hallway to The Cotton Corner to continue your fabric shopping. We will depart Yoder's for a Amish Quilt Trunk Show and Haystack Dinner inside an Amish home. 'Haystack' is like an "upside down taco salad" served family style to the table. Following the meal, Rebecca Haarer will tell us the history of Amish quilting before heading to Essenhaus Inn to check in for the night.

Day 2, Friday, May 6, 2022 (B, & L)

After breakfast at the hotel, we will check out and depart for Goshen, Indiana to visit a rural country quilt fabric shop called Calico Point. Then off to Topeka for Emmatown Fabric & Gifts. Next, Alaine Jones invites us to join her and family and friends in an Amish quilting bee. The ladies will demonstrate how to piece, mark and get the quilt ready to sew. Then you get a chance to participate, watch, learn or just chat as these Amish ladies lead the novice and experienced quilter in an old-fashioned quilting bee. Our dinner will be an Amish Wedding Feast. We will feast on a traditional Amish wedding dinner as Elaine and her son Seth explain what an Amish wedding day is like. We then depart Topeka for one more stop in Shipshewana at the E&S Bulk Food Store, the Amish version of Wal-Mart. We will arrive home around 7:00 pm (no dinner stop).
